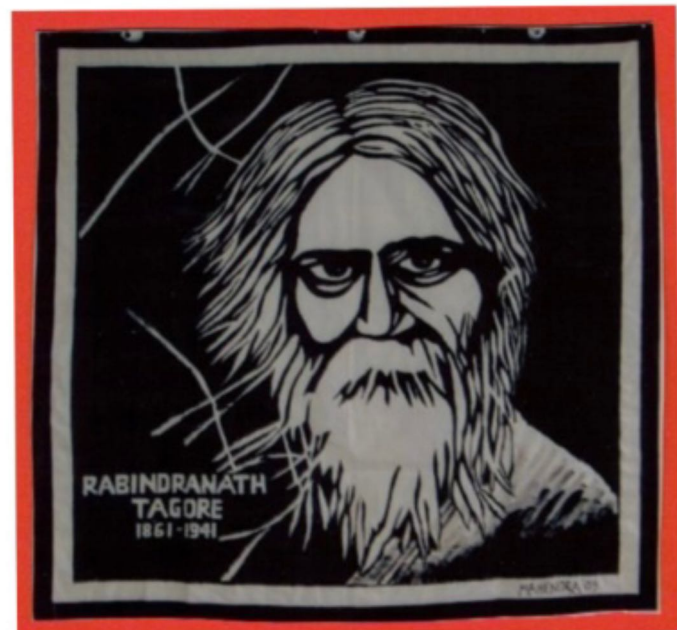
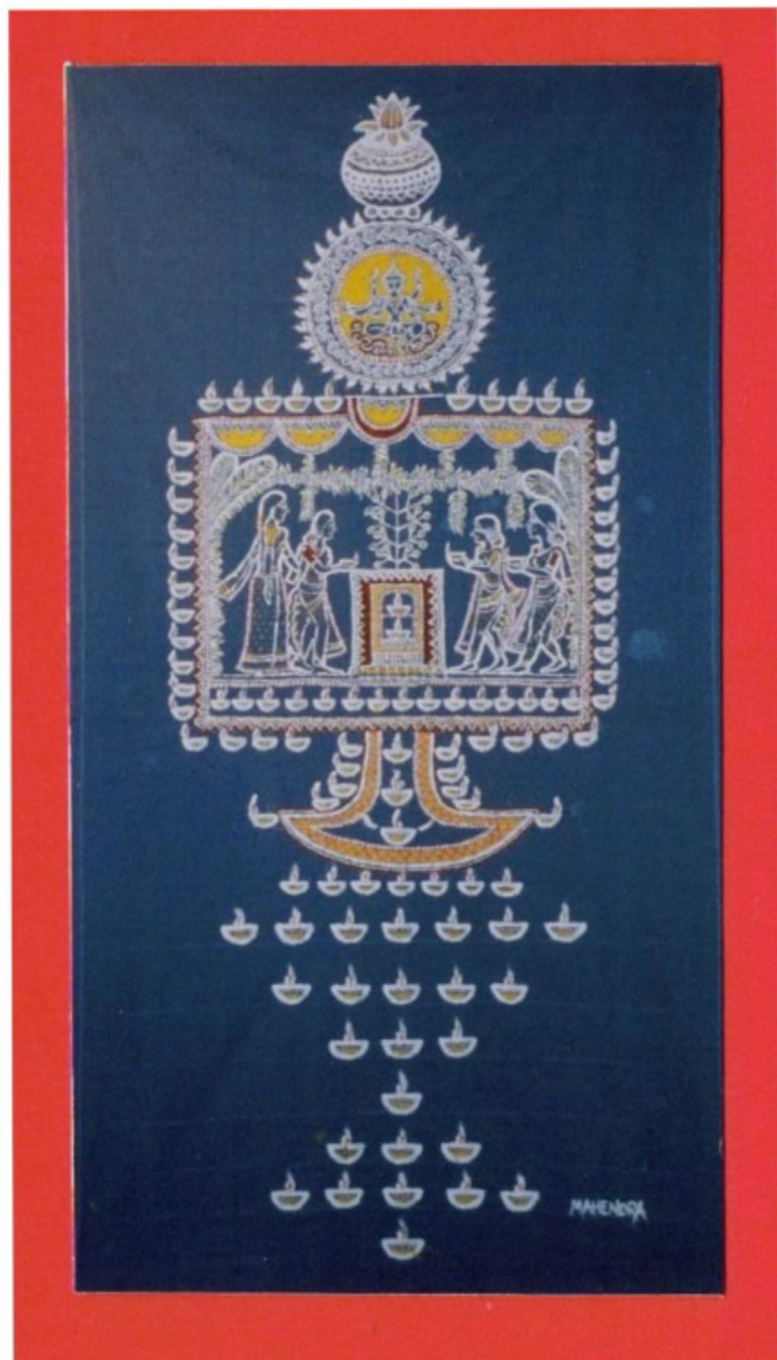
Ravan effigy
